A Message from the School Nurse

All Pre-Kindergarten students need to make sure their immunizations are up to date before the beginning of their Kindergarten year. Many are still lacking immunizations. All 6th grade students going into the seventh grade are required to have a TDAP immunization in order to attend school. This immunization can be obtained through your child's physician, many pharmacies and the county Health Department. If you choose not to immunize your child, you must file for an exemption through the State of

Oklahoma. Forms are available at https://www.ok.gov/health2/documents/imm_school_odh_216a_certificate_of_exemption.pdf

Complete the form and bring it to the office at South Rock Creek. The form must be submitted by the school. Students without the proper immunizations or exemptions will not be allowed to start school. If you have any questions, please call the school at 273-6072.

No paperwork will be accepted before May 21, 9 a.m.

Open Transfer Application must be turned in BEFORE enrollment paperwork will be accepted (if student does not live in-district).

Pre-K is a four-year-old program. Students must be 4-years-old by September 1, 2018, and no older than four on September 1, 2018.

You must have the following to enroll:

- 1) Certified Birth Certificate
- 2) CDIB card (if applicable)
- 3) Proof of Residence (i.e. utility bill) or Transfer
- 4) Updated Immunization Record
