Students living in SRC School District will be served first!

Enrollment Packets available on SRC website in May.

No paperwork will be accepted before May 15, 8 a.m.

Open Transfer Application must be turned in BEFORE enrollment paperwork will be accepted (if student does not live in-district).

Pre-K is a four-year-old program. Students must be 4-years-old by September 1, 2019, and no older than four on September 1, 2019.

You must have the following to enroll:

- 1) Certified Birth Certificate
- 2) CDIB card (if applicable)
- 3) Proof of Residence (i.e. utility bill) or Transfer
- 4) Updated Immunization Record

A Message from the School Nurse, Cheryl Wines, RN

All Pre-K students need up to date immunizations before the first day of Kindergarten. All 6th graders going into 7th grade are required to have a TDAP immunization in order to attend school. This immunization can be obtained through your child's physician, many pharmacies, and the county Health Department. If you choose not to immunize your child, you must file for an exemption through the State of Oklahoma. Forms are available at https://www.ok.gov/health2/documents/imm_school_odh_216a_certificate_of_exemption.pdf. Bring completed form to the SRC office. The form must be submitted by the school. Students without the proper immunizations or exemptions will not be allowed to start school. If you have any questions, please call the school at 273-6072.
